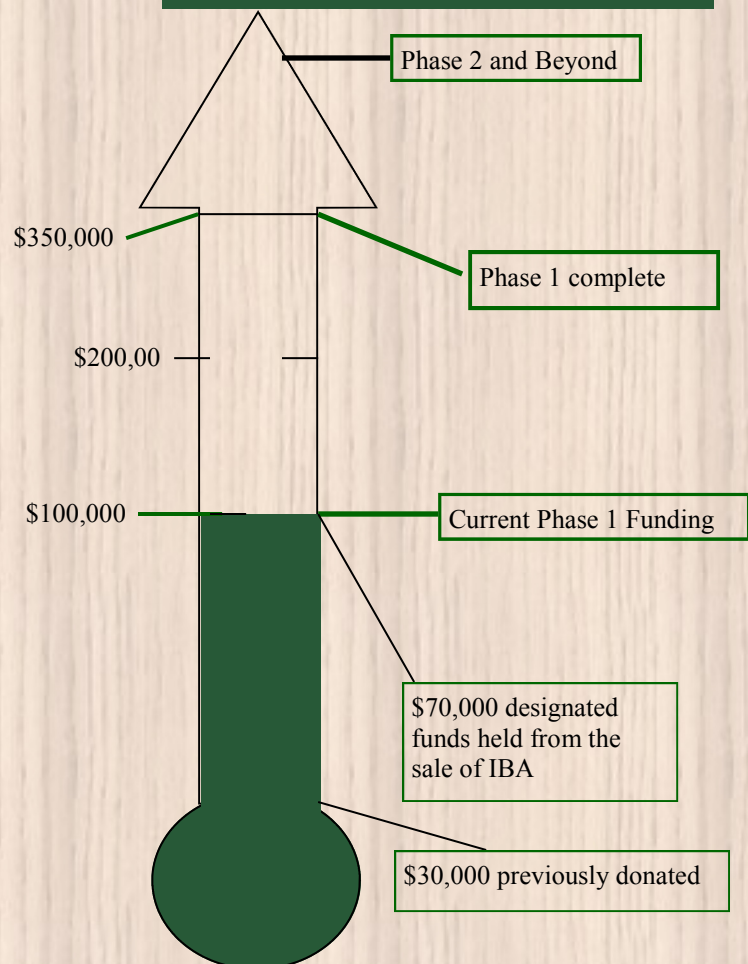

# Foundational Growth:

## Where we've been in the last 5 years

### Water:

- Replacement of main junctions to girls shower house and dining hall
- Replacement of entire shower houses plumbing system to Pex manifold system
- Replacement of kitchen plumbing to Pex manifold system
- Repaired and replaced nearly every water heater to more efficient systems
- Installed new water bottle filling station

### Major repairs:

- Replaced entire water line (~1200 feet) with major connection
- Replaced entire main septic line (~800 feet)
- Repaired septic tank and line from pool house to main line (~200 feet)
- Installed 2 new grease trap/treatment tanks (~5,000 gallon) behind dining hall
- Installed new pool pump and filter system to be more efficient
- Installed new pool plumbing system to be more intuitive and efficient

### Electrical:

- Replaced entire electrical system in the chapel to be more efficient and cost effective
- Replaced entire electrical system in girls area: new main panel, new panels in all cabins, new panel in shower house.
- Replaced single bulb CFL's with protected tube fluorescents in every cabin

### Structural:

- Constructed 3 new open air shelter houses (Chapel shelter, Friendship Shelter, Pond Shelter)
- Completed remodel of 2 shower houses (new shower partitions, new high quality paint, new floor epoxy, new sinks and faucets, new shower fixtures)
- Installed new drywall ceiling in director's cabin and nurses station
- Installed drop ceiling in office and conference room
- Installed drywall in manager's office
- Installed new windows in chapel
- Installed new windows in the lodge
- Installed new countertops in lodge basement restrooms
- Installed new shower fixtures in lodge private restrooms
- Constructed new deck on front of lodge
- Constructed elements for a Challenge course
- Constructed awnings for every stone cabin
- Repaired doors on all cabins
- Installed new roof on Freedom cabin
- Constructed new multi-purpose facility for dining
