- ➔ Understanding boundaries can help ministry leaders manage the difficulties inherent in the role of clergy or spiritual leaders.
- ➔ Knowledge of what is appropriate, what is not, and whether an action is in the best interest of congregants or students can help clergy, church leaders and teachers avoid possible boundary violations.
- ➔ Required for Ordination and CLI Leadership and Ministry Program Credentials.
- ➔ Essential for clergy, but also strongly recommended for church lay leaders such as deacons, Sunday school teachers, small group leaders and visitation teams.
- ➔ Continuing Education Units provided.
