Missional Church Learning Experience (MCLE) is a cluster of churches that form a **Learning Community** to explore what God is saying to the church today.

Each church forms a **Mission Team** that receives training in basic missional church principles, and practices those principles by designing and implementing a small community project.

The Learning Community will meet during the process to share what they are learning and receive further training.

Each Church

- Establishes a Mission Team of 5 members
 - The pastor
 - Four lay members (one of whom is 15-29 in age)
- Attends the three sessions & four technology meetings
- Completes three assignments to help design the community project
- Implements the project
- Shares their learnings
