Franklin College was founded in 1834 by Baptist pioneers and maintains a voluntary association with American Baptist Churches USA. There are a number of scholarship opportunities available for students from American Baptist Churches.

- > Franklin College has two endowed scholarships for American Baptist students. To be considered you must indicate on your college application that you are American Baptist and give the name of your church.

- Franklin College will match scholarships from local American Baptist Churches up to \$250 per semester or \$500 per school year. Check with your pastor to inquire about church scholarships.
