## About the Instructor:



Rev. Rodney Lynch has been serving as pastor-director of the Baptist Student Foundation (The Found) at Purdue University since 2016. He has his B.A. in social science from The College of New Rochelle, an M. Div. from Drew Theological Seminary, and was named “Theological Student of the Year” for outstanding generosity and dedication there. While he was president of Drew’s Black Ministerial Caucus (BMC), the group was named “Theological School Organization of the Year.”

He next completed a Master of Sacred Theology (S.T.M.) at Drew and is currently pursuing a D. Min. from United Theological Seminary, where his focus is “*Prophetic Activism: From the Cross to the Community.*”

He regularly guides faith leaders/congregations through a “Racial At(one)ment” experiential learning module to help bring racial healing to Greater Lafayette. Rodney is an adjunct professor at Ivy Tech Community College, teaching “*Understanding Diversity and Cultural Awareness,*” and is a chaplain of the West Lafayette Police Department.

He is a dedicated servant of Christ committed to “Do Justice, love kindness and walk humbly with our God.” Fighting against all forms of oppression through the lens of the “Religion of Jesus” (Luke 4:18 - 19) is where Rodney’s beliefs are anchored.
