WHY THIS COURSE?

- Understanding boundaries can help ministry leaders manage the difficulties inherent in the role of clergy or spiritual leaders.
- Attaining knowledge of what is appropriate, what is not, and whether an action is in the best interest of congregants or students can help clergy, church leaders, and teachers avoid possible boundary violations.
- Gaining discernment about those circumstances when it is consistent with our calling to cross boundaries enables us to challenge systemic injustices with prophetic truth.
- Required for Ordination and M28 Certificate in Theological Education.
- Essential for clergy but also strongly recommended for church lay leaders such as deacons, Sunday school teachers, small group leaders, and visitation teams.
