#### WHERE DO WE FIND THE CHURCH THESE DAYS?

One of the questions asked by the *Fresh Expressions* leader at our Biennial keeps coming to mind. We were asked, "Where did Jesus do ministry?" I love simple questions that make me think about the life of Jesus. I thought about the mountain, the plain, the Temple, the tomb, the sycamore fig tree, and many places where Jesus ministered to people to convey the Gospel. In each of these encounters, we find the Kingdom work that Jesus came to do. It is Holy work. I love to read the Gospels and each of these encounters. As I sat and listened to our presenters, I was challenged to follow the steps of Jesus and to take the Gospel to the mountains, plains, prisons, and hospitals. We should find the church in these places but often do not.

I have come to believe that the main barrier keeping the church from a ministry that looks like the ministry of Jesus is the quenching of the Holy Spirit. I gave my life to Jesus as a child and have been blessed by the presence of the Holy Spirit for my entire life. I cannot imagine not having the Holy Spirit present in my life to seal me, lead me,

convict me, and love me. Without the Holy Spirit, there is no good in me. The acts of the sinful nature are obvious as Galatians 5 tells us, but as a church, we are often more focused on these acts than we are on the fruit of the Spirit that is shared in the same passage. The fruit that comes from the manifestation of the Spirit in our lives is meant to feed *all* people.

When Jesus left to return to the Father, He promised that another would come that would allow us to do even greater things (John 14:12-17). I have always marveled at that statement. "Greater things?" But, how? Just like Jesus,

we are called to love others and not focus on their sin or who they are when left to that sin. Jesus distinguished His ministry from that of the Pharisees by loving others no matter their guilt. This is mercy. We can only do this when we live in the Holy Spirit. This is where we will find the church, hopefully the Baptist church. Let us be this church as we walk "TOGETHER on God's Abundant Journey."






#### EVANSVILLE FBC REMAINS ACTIVE IN MISSION OUTREACH











Since 2022, First Baptist Church Evansville, Ind. has been without a Senior Pastor. The congregation (formed in 1847) has continued to spread the Gospel under a committed leadership team. The church continues many ministries sharing the love of Christ!

Their Operation Christmas Child effort filled 2,200 boxes last Christmas. They support Little Dresses for Africa and provide monthly meals for Cancer Pathways. Every Thanksgiving they support Evansville Rescue Mission by donating canned goods. They support Patchwork Central with monthly donations as well

The congregation is currently providing space in their building for Weekday Religious Education staff who have been conducting weekly classes for children in the public schools since 1942. Yet this partnership between Evansville First Baptist and the program's staff began very recently in August 2024.

Every Sunday the church has a group of 20-25 members who meet for fellowship and breakfast. It is a great way to welcome new members! Monthly they have a carry-in dinner enjoying food and fellowship together after worship.


Church members also attend monthly meetings of the Downtown Evansville Economic Improvement District to build stronger ties with their community. - "Fresh Expressions!"

#### FUSE EVENTS MOVING INTO OTHER AREAS OF THE REGION

On October 6, another FUSE Student Gathering occurred in the central part of the Region at Southeastern Baptist Youth Camp (SBYC). Over 50 students and leaders from eight different ABC-IN/KY churches came together for a few hours. Students went on a relaxing ride around the camp, played BlasterBall, did some black light painting and climbed the rock wall at the camp. They ended their time together with a shared meal and a message from Tyler Griffin, Youth Pastor of Kimberlin Creek BC. The heart behind the FUSE Student Gatherings is to see students connect with God and one another.

At press time, we were looking forward to having our first FUSE in the southwestern part of the Region hosted by First Baptist Church Petersburg (October 20), and we hope to offer FUSE in the northern part of the Region in early 2025. FUSE is for students in grades 6-12 connected with any of our ABC-IN/KY churches. Whether your church has an active youth group or not, we'd love to have your students with us at FUSE!


"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Mathew 28:19 NIV.




